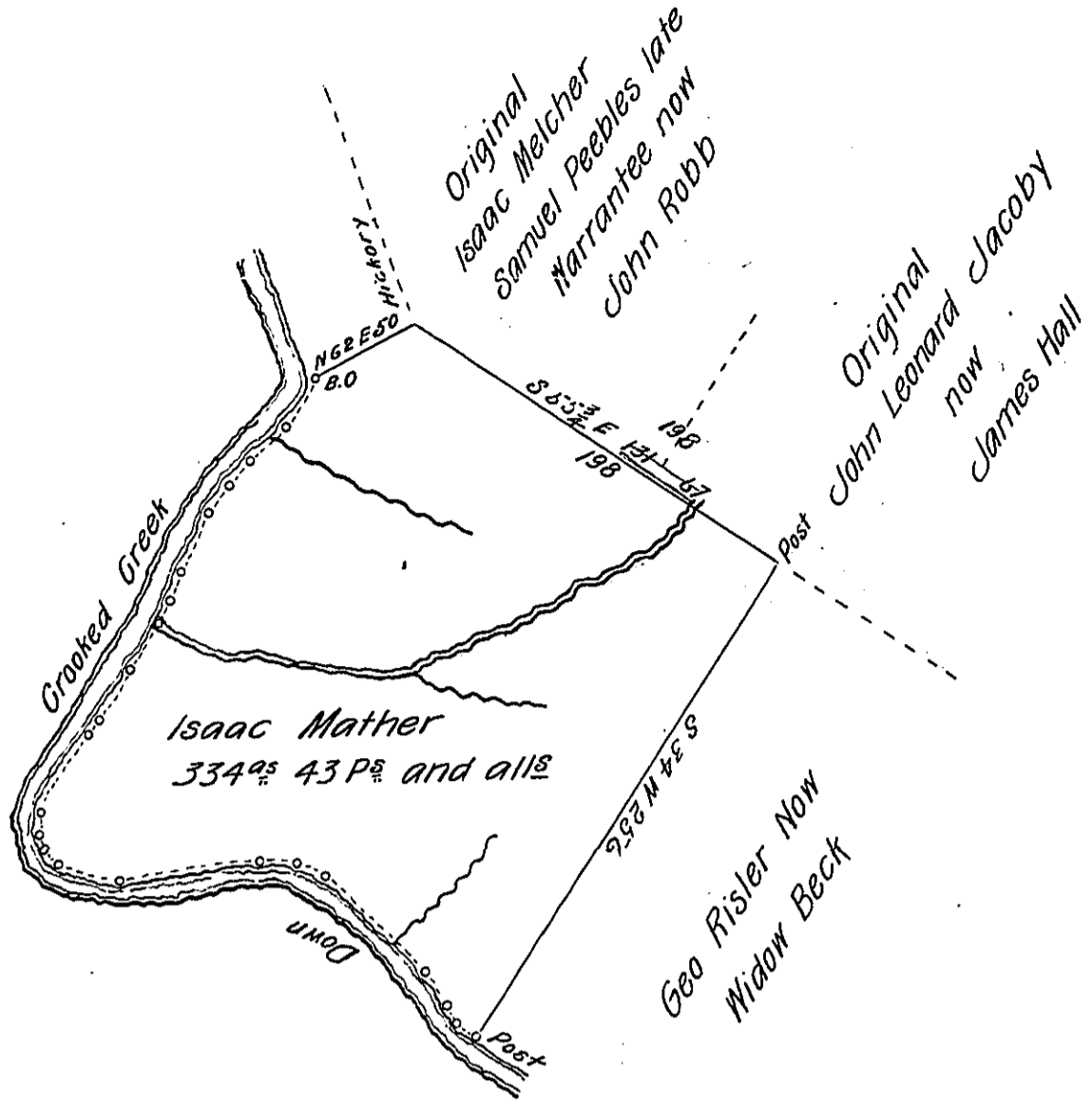

Resurveyed the above described tract of land containing three hundred and thirty four acres, forty three perches, and the allowance of six P^r G^t &c. situate in Kittanning township Armstrong County, bounded by Crooked Creek and lands of John Robb, James Hall, Widow Beck &c. now in possession of Peter Roopart, tennant, for the heirs of Thomas Hamilton late of the Borough of Kittanning deceased. Being the same land once before Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Isaac Mather dated Aug^t 20th A. D. 1776. and resurveyed for the heirs of Th^s Hamilton d^d.
