



Situate in Barree township Huntingdon County. Containing one hundred ninety eight acres, one hundred & twenty perches and the usual allowance of Six per Cent &c. Being part of a tract of land Surveyed 21<sup>st</sup> day of June 1819 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to David McMurtrie the 26<sup>th</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1817. The whole tract was then said to contain two hundred thirty one acres twenty eight perches &c. The dotted lines representing the original Survey. This part resurveyed and divided from the residue the 2<sup>d</sup> day of Janu<sup>y</sup> 1837.
