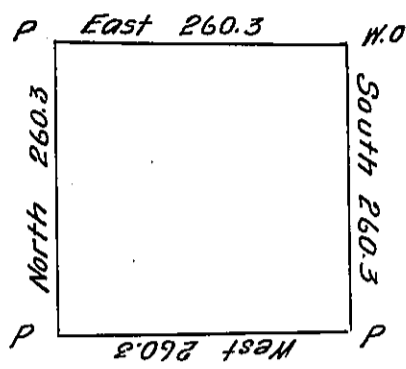

 four hundred acres with the usual allowance of 6 P. Cent &c.
