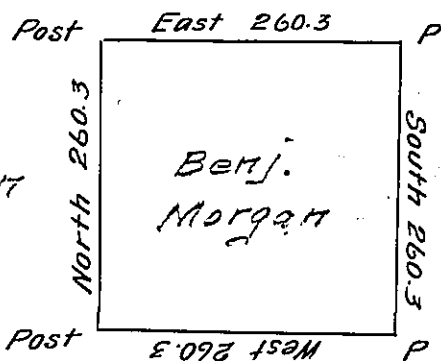

The above is the draught of a Survey made Decem<sup>ber</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> 1794  
 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Benjamin Morgan on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April  
 1792. Situate Northwest of the Ohio River on the Waters of Beaver Creek  
 adjoining land granted to Thomas L. Moore. Called Calahona. Containing  
 four hundred acres with the usual allowance of 6 P Cent &c.
