 of a Location or Order of Survey No 3087 dated the 17th
 April 1769 said Survey has since been divided into sev-
 eral parts as represented that part marked A is the
 part now proposed to be patented also B if the neces-
 sary papers can be forwarded in due time in order to
 give a correct explanation of the circumstances, I have
 caused a resurvey of A & B to be made on the 5th Inst-
 ant & a description of the several parts for illucida-
 tion.
