Resurveyed the 15<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. 1817 by virtue of a warrant granted to Hugh McMillen & John Witzner dated the 31<sup>st</sup> day of January 1786 - It being a part of a larger tract containing 875<sup>as</sup> 136 ps & allowance - Originally surveyed by Matthew Henderson on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of February 1786
