



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate on the West Side of Sasquehanna River joining Marcus Huling's Claim; In Fermanough Township in Cumberland County; Containing Five Hundred and Twenty Seven Acres and the usual Allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads. Surveyed to Samuel Neave August Twenty ninth day Anno Domini 1761. In Pursuance of the Honourable Proprietaries Two Warrants granted him the first Dated the fifth day of March Anno Domini 1755. The Second Warrant Dated the Thirtieth day of June Anno Domini 1755.
