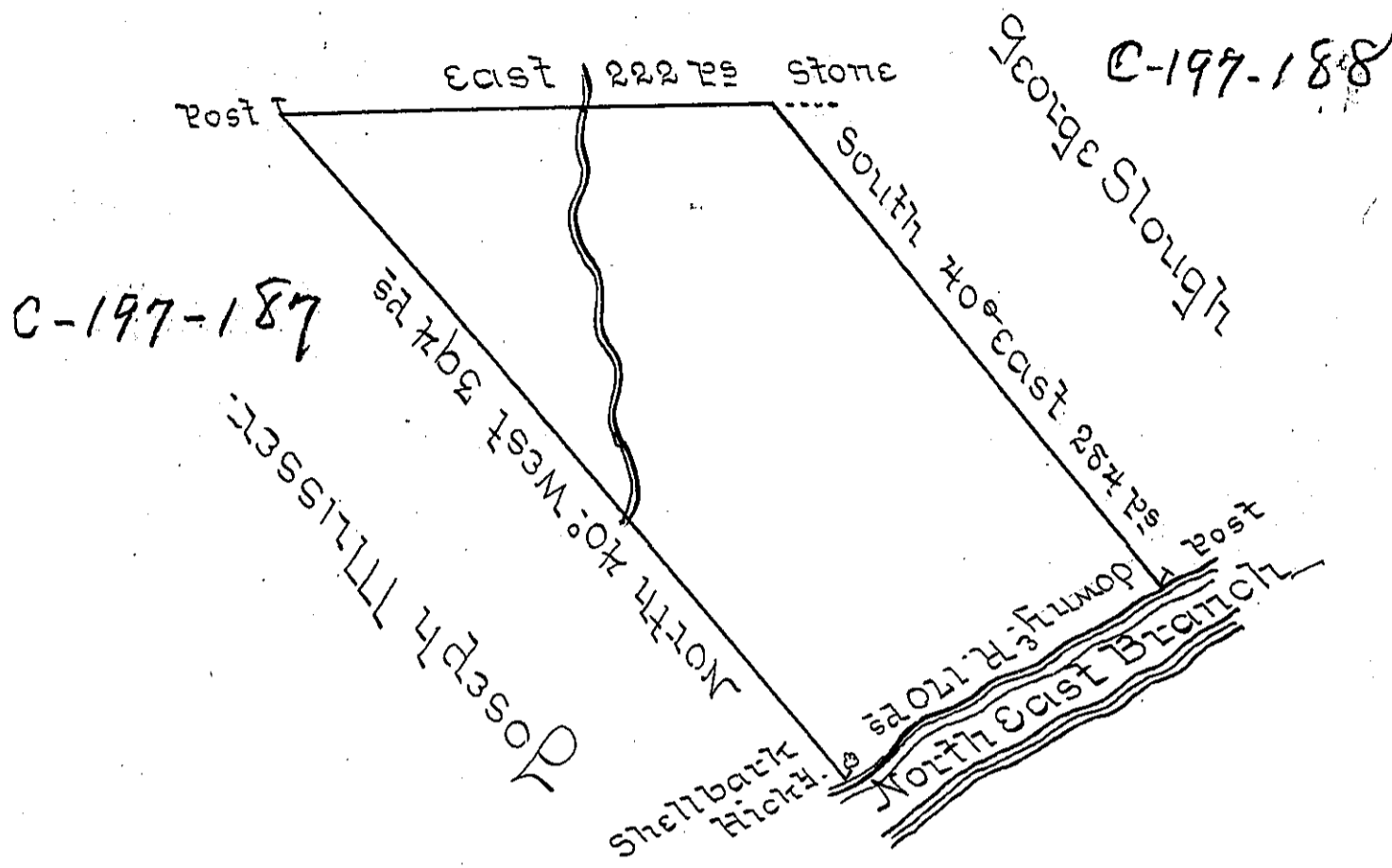


Vacant.
