



The above is a draught of a tract of land called the Dry ridge situate in Buffalo Township and county of Washington, containing thirty three acres and eight perches with the usual allowance surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant for forty acres granted to James McKinney dated May 21st 1816 and executed May 31st 1816. At the time of survey there was an improvement and a family residing on the land; a constant resident settlement has been kept up ever since the time of the first improvement in 1800. There is no opposing claim whatever.
