



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 17<sup>th</sup> of October 1737 The Above Described Tract of Land was Surveyed unto John Brown in Robinson Township in the County of Lancaster Beginning at a Chestnut Tree Standing by the River Schuylkill thence up the Same on the Several Courses thereof 165 perches to a Black Oak thence South West by the Improvement of Griffith Rees 23 1/4 Perches to a Stone thence South 59 Degrees East by Vacant Land 165 perches to a Hickory thence North East by the Land of Israel Robinson 28 1/2 Perches to the Place of Beginning Containing Two Hundred thirty Four Acres beside the Allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads  
 21<sup>st</sup> of 8<sup>mo</sup> 1737 P. Sam. Lightfoot.
