



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioners of
 Property dated the 10th day of June 1872 a Survey was made
 on the above of the following a certain lot of ground in
 the town of Harrisburg in the County of Northumberland
 more particularly described in an official plan of said town number
 one hundred and forty seven for Benjamin Gibbs
 containing in breadth east and west on Newberry Street
 six feet and in length North and South two hundred
 and thirty feet bounded southward by Newberry Street
 westward by Number One hundred and forty six
 eastward by Newberry Street and eastward by lot
 Number One hundred and forty six - returned to
 the Recorder's Office the 23rd day of June 1874 by
 George Young Surveyor of Northumberland County.
