



A draught of a tract of land called the three Bottoms situated on the North Branch of Comalloway Creek about a mile below Francis Reynolds & a quarter of a mile below the mouth of Barren run including the improvement of Edward Morton in Bethel Township in the County of Bedford containing sixty three acres & the usual allowance of six Per cent for roads &c surveyed the 2<sup>d</sup> day of September 1774 for Joseph Warford in pursuance of an order N<sup>o</sup> 1934 dated the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November 1766 by
