



A draft of $207^{\circ} 112^{\circ}$ and allowance situate in Lackawanna township Mercer County surveyed March 3rd 1821 to James Young and William Orr in pursuance of a warrant granted to William McEtheney dated 22nd January 1802

Improvements have been a cabin house and about eight or ten acres cleared fenced and cultivated

It appears from the books in my office that John Finley formerly a deputy surveyor of this County did on the 10th day of December 1802 survey the above land on said warrant which survey interfered with the donation and by the above survey said interference is removed
