



Surveyed on the 6th day of September 1814 the above described tract of land containing one hundred and twenty acres and allowance of six per cent &c It being part of, and laid off the west end of a larger tract, of which the dotted lines represent, and was surveyed (as appears by the books handed over to me by my predecessor in office) (on the 25th day of March 1809, to Archabald McCall and John Mounts and Jesse Young containing four hundred acres and thirty eight perches and alle: &c. by George Ross then D Surveyor of this County in pursuance of warrant dated 6th March 1809 and returned 13th October 1810 by Isaac Moor being the surveyor of this County at 5^d time) situate N.W. of the Allegeny river on the waters of Limestone — and adjoining lands of Frances Johnston Esq.^r Martin John Valentine Bowser and the residue of the said larger tract Sugar Creek Township Armstrong County
