



The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 30<sup>th</sup> of January 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to William Nichols Jun<sup>r</sup> for 400 Ac<sup>s</sup> of Land Dated the 4<sup>th</sup> of January 1794 Situate North and West of the River Ohio on the Waters of Slippery Rock Creek Ad-joining Land Granted to Francis Nichols. Called Woodbridge Containing four Hundred <sup>one</sup> & Acres and the Usual Allowance of Six P<sup>ct</sup> Cent for Roads.
