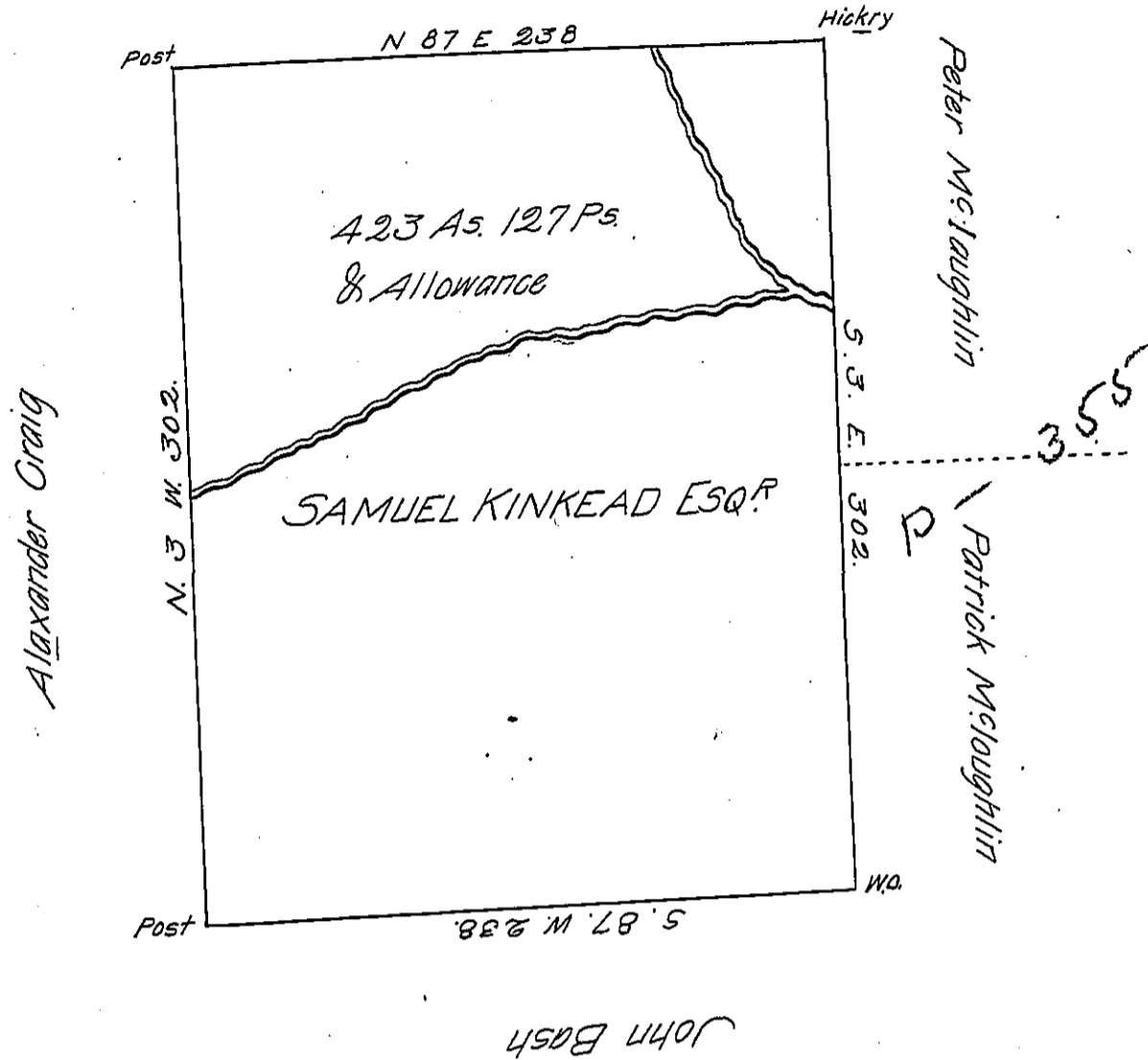

Calling for four hundred Acres and adjoining Joseph Nixon on the west, the Same being transfared to Samuel Kinkead Esq.^r who is now residing on the above describ'd tract of land, the Heairs of David Rankin is said to hold under Joseph Nixon Alaxander Craig Setler
