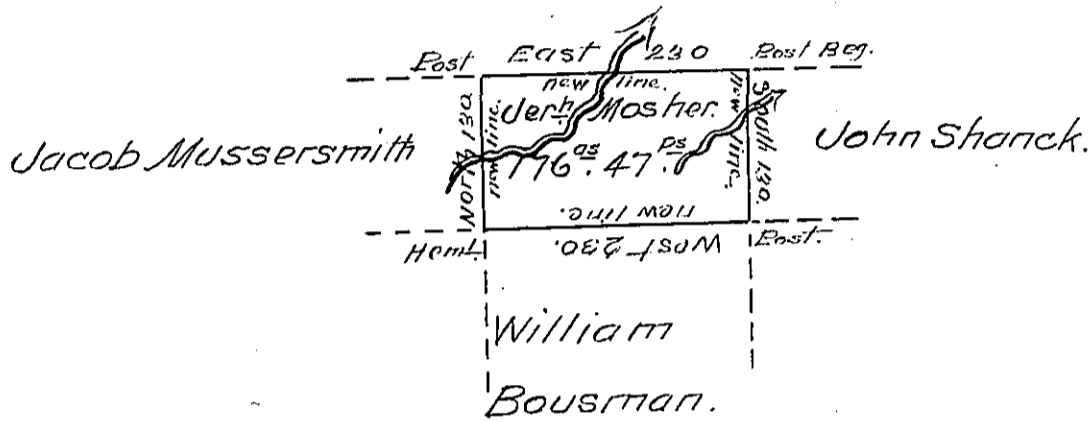

SITUATE in Beccaria Township Clearfield County. Containing One hundred seventy six acres forty seven perches, and the usual allowance for roads &c. Resurveyed 22<sup>d</sup>. of April 1813. agreeably to an Order of the Board of Property dated \*17<sup>th</sup> October 1810; for Hardman Philips & Co. upon which a return of a Survey was made for 433<sup>as</sup> 153<sup>ps</sup> &c. dated 15<sup>th</sup> July 1793. In pursuance of a warrant granted to Jeremiah Mosher dated 16<sup>th</sup> January 1793.
