



A Draught of a Tract of Land, situate in Upper Milford Township in the County of Northampton (formerly Bucks) in the Province of Pennsylvania Containing Fifty one Acres and 115 Perches of Land together with the usual allowance at Six per Cent for Roads; That formerly was Surveyed to Ludowick Pitting, in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to him by the Hon<sup>ble</sup>. Proprietaries Dated the 13<sup>th</sup> March Anno-1744. - The said Ludowick Pitting since Sold his Right to the same unto Andrew Graber - for whom it was Resurveyed on the 7<sup>th</sup> - September Anno-1772 By order of the Surveyor General.
