



A Draught of a Lot of Ground in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Twelve Situate on the South side of High Street Containing in Breadth East and West Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two hundred and forty feet. Bounded Northward by High Street aforesaid Westward by Lot Number four, Southward by a Twenty feet Alley, and Eastward by Lot Number Twenty. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1774 for John Pollock Carpenter by warrant dated the same day
