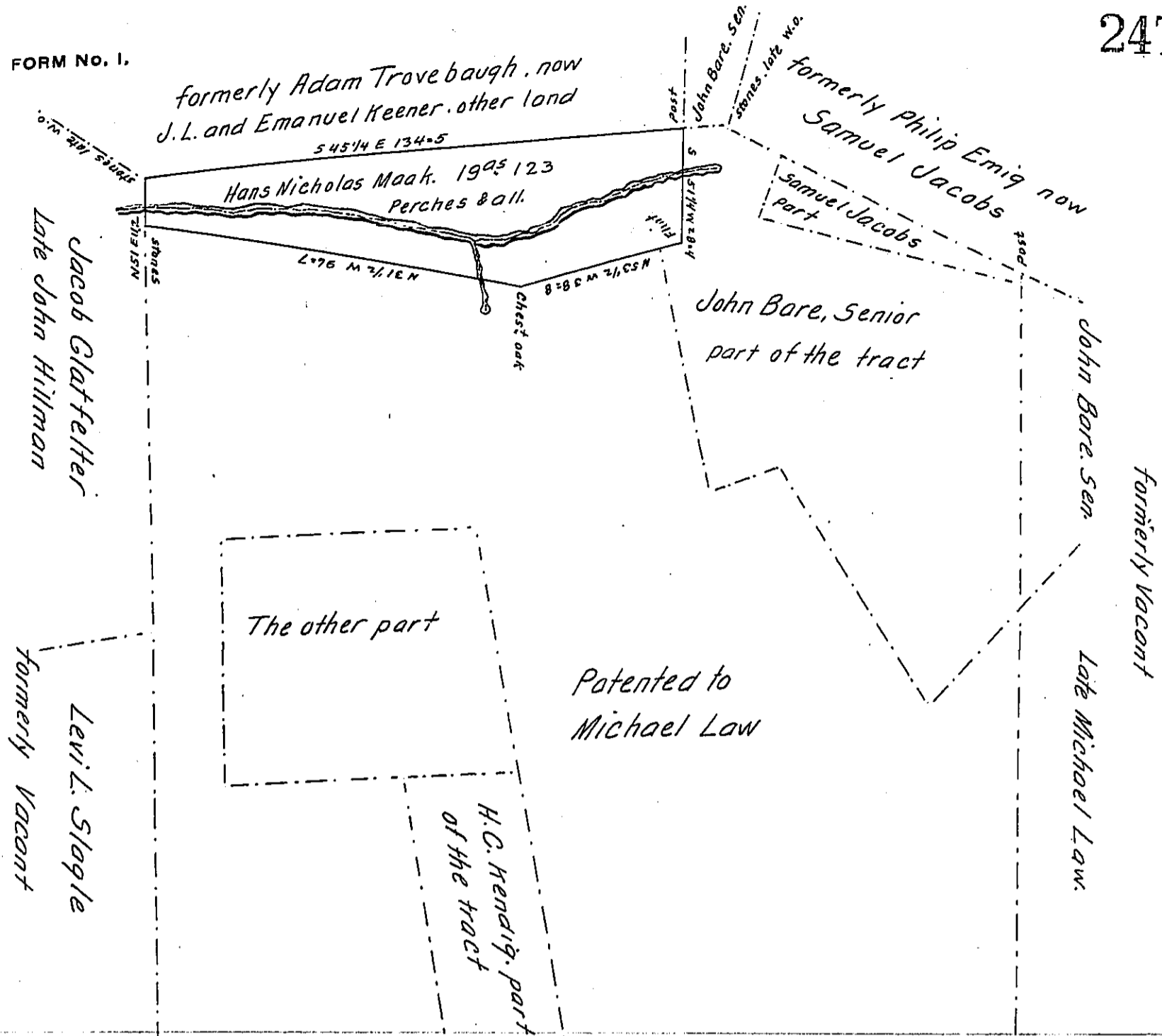


FORM NO. 1.

Which was Originally Surveyed on the 23<sup>d</sup> day of October 1751 by George Stevenson, late D.S. in pursuance of a warrant for 150<sup>ac</sup> Granted to Hans Nicholas Maak, bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1750. Since divided &c. Now on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September A. D. 1871. Examined, Calculated and found Correct, and at the request of John L. Keener & Emanuel Keener, the present owner, the Same is Returned for Confirmation, and for to Patent the Same.
