



Situated on the Great Road leading from Union Town to Fort Cumberland in Wharton township Fayette County and surveyed the 17th day of April 1787 & returned in consequence of a Warrant granted to W^m Og Senior for 400⁰⁰ of land including an improvement on the Negroe Glade run adjoining land—Benjamin Chew and others in Turkeyfoot township which improvement and location on examination was found to be on a Tract of land already appropriated and surveyed to Chew and Wilcocks by Warrant dated the 5th day of October 1774
