In pursuance of an act of Assembly passed the 12th day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and seal of Office from John Lukens Esq^r Surveyor Gen^l for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22nd day of August 1783- The above tract of land Containing Two hundred & Six acres and Twenty perches and allowance of 6. p Cent for roads &c was surveyed on the 11th day of June 1785 by
