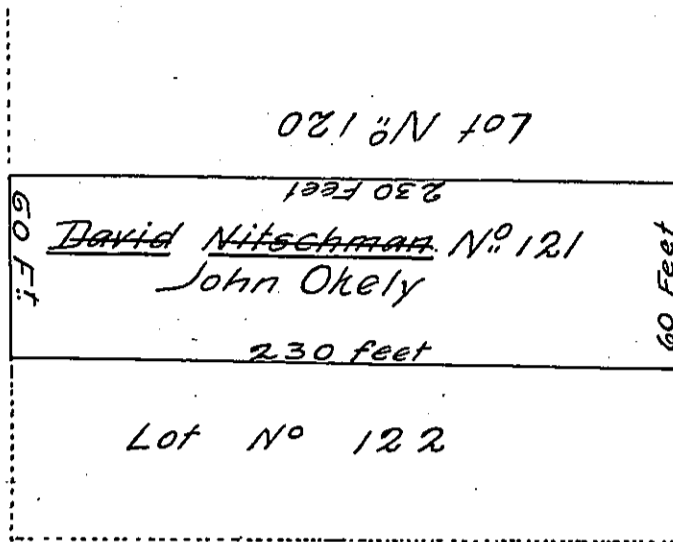


Pomfret Street
