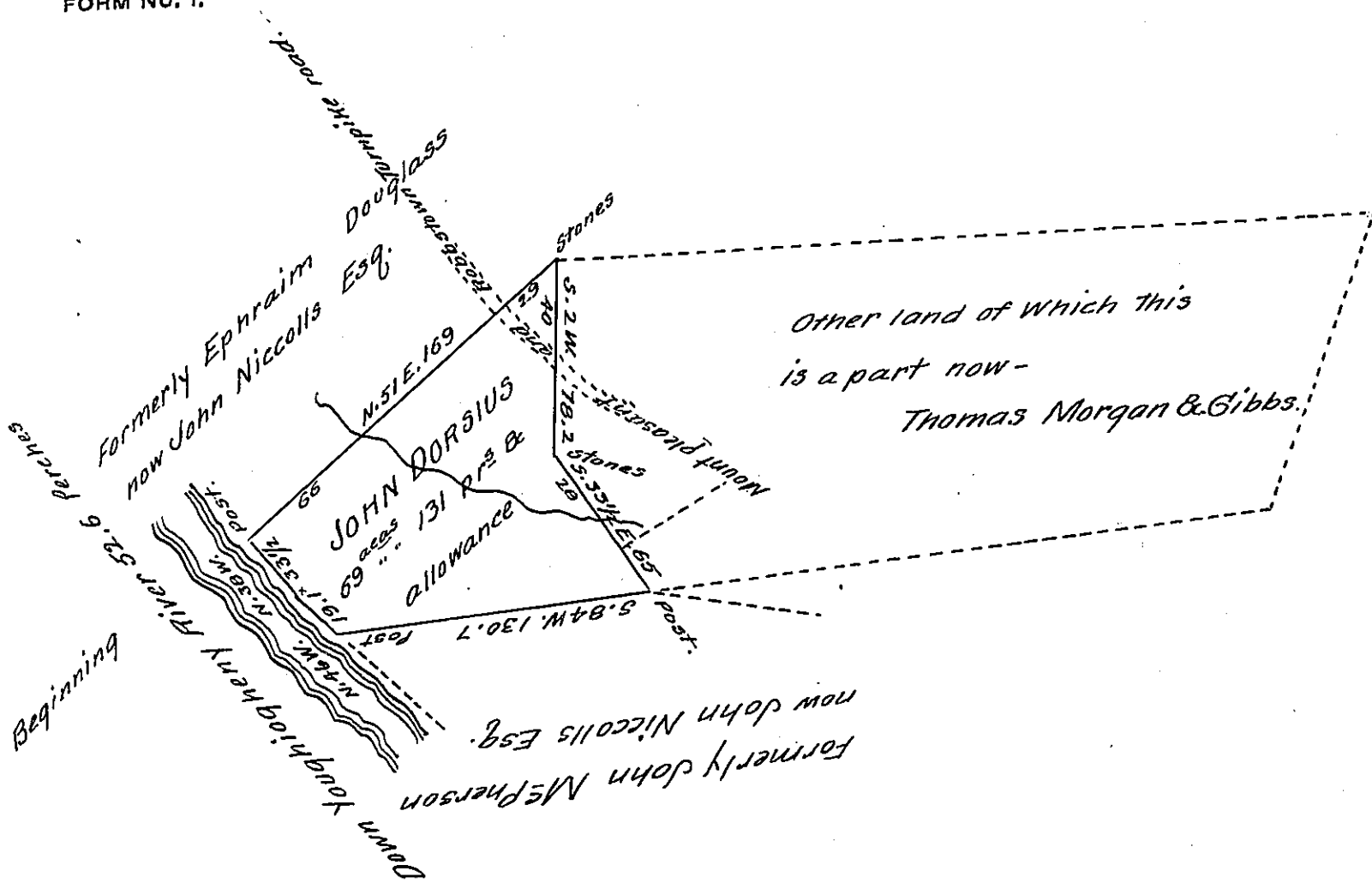


FORM NO. 1.



A draught of a part of a tract of land which was surveyed in pursuance of an Application granted to John Dorsius No 2191 dated April 3<sup>d</sup> 1769 containing Sixty nine acres one hundred and thirty one perches, and the allowance proportioned at six per Cent for roads &c. Situate on the Mountain Pleasant and Robbstown Turnpike road adjoining the Youghiogheny River in South-Huntingdon township in Formerly Bedford now Westmoreland County, Surveyed March 31<sup>st</sup> 1830.
