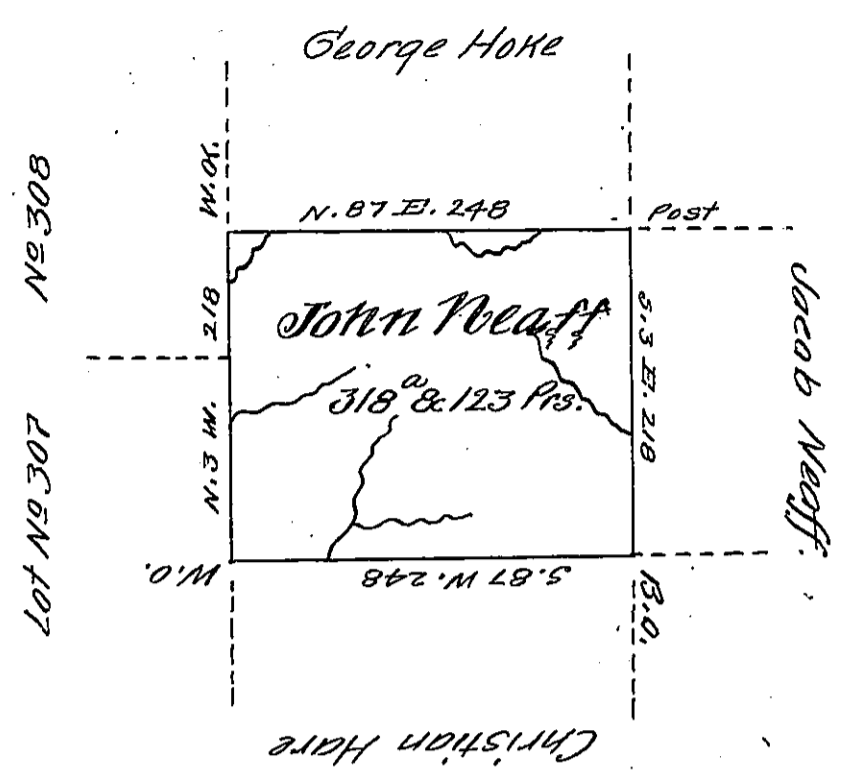

 acres & 123 Perches of Land with the allowance of six P. Cent &c. In pursuance
