



A Draught of a Survey called the double dispute, situate in Fayette Township in Allegheny County, containing 380 ac^s 48 ps and the usual allowances executed Sept. 6th 1799 in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Jn^o Nickle for 380 Ac^s dated March the 22^d 1798 - of the above 108 ac^s is claimed by W^m Harvey for whom it was surveyed on the 30th June 1786 on a warr^t in his own name July 27th 1785 - & 11 ac^s & 22 ps is claimed by W^m Marks - The red space is Harvey's Survey - the Orange D^o is W^m Marks's claim.
