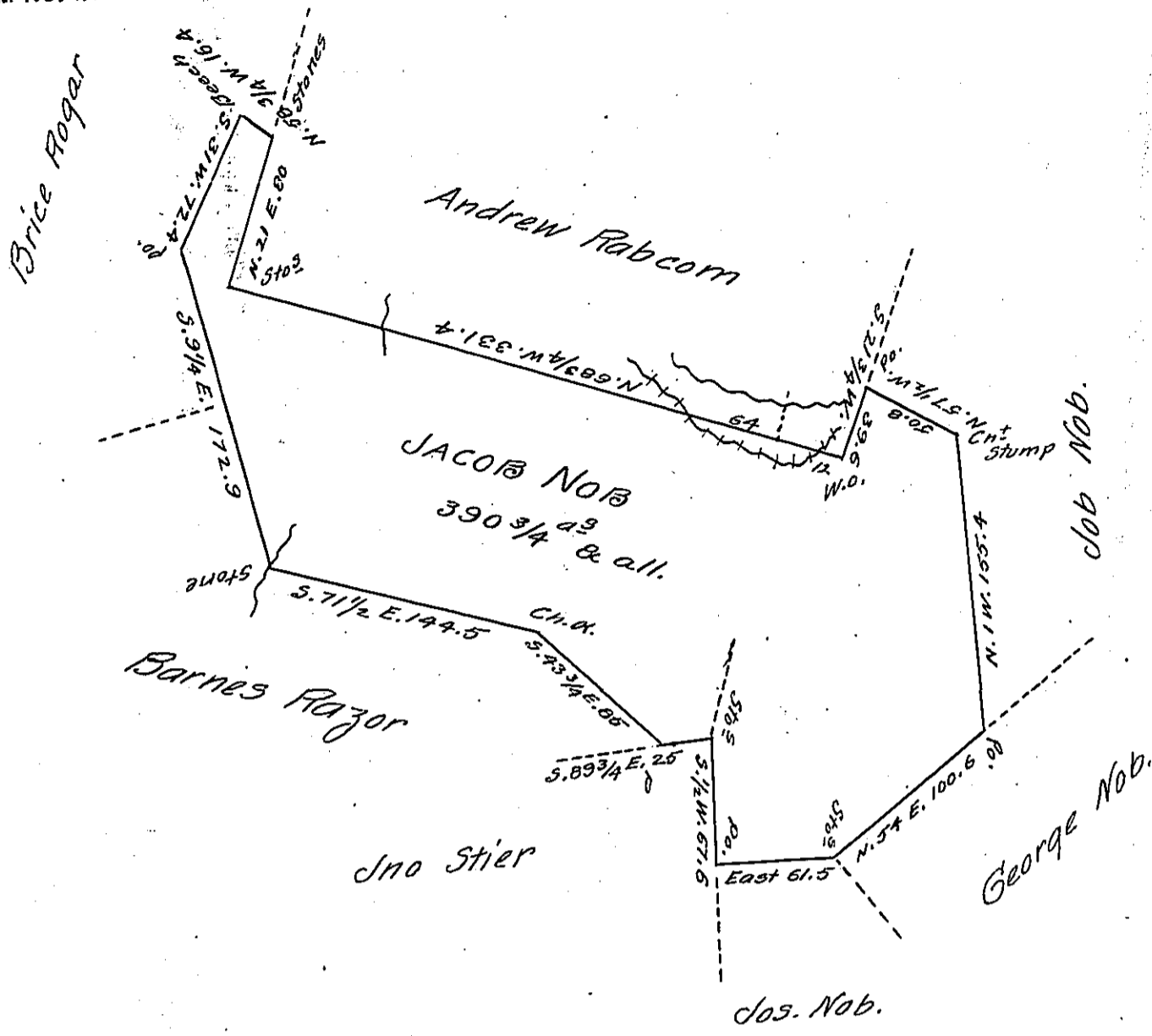


FORM NO. 1.

In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Jacob Nob for 400^{ac} dated the ³⁰ 4th day of ~~February~~ ^{January} 1794 - There is about 70^{ac} cleared, a log house Stable Barn &c and a family resident on this part. Supposed to have been settled 30 years or more.
