



A Draft of two hundred and twenty one acres and sixty perches of land with six per Cent for Roads situate in Derry township in Mifflin, late Cumberland County, which is a part of a tract of land surveyed in pursuance of an order of survey to Isaac Bartram dated 15<sup>th</sup> September 1766 numbered 1243 said to contain 327 9/10 acres, and which appears to have been resurveyed & divided 12<sup>th</sup> Aug<sup>st</sup> 1803 by Wm Harris late Deputy Surveyor for the Rev<sup>d</sup> Thomas Mifflinger and - Swift.
