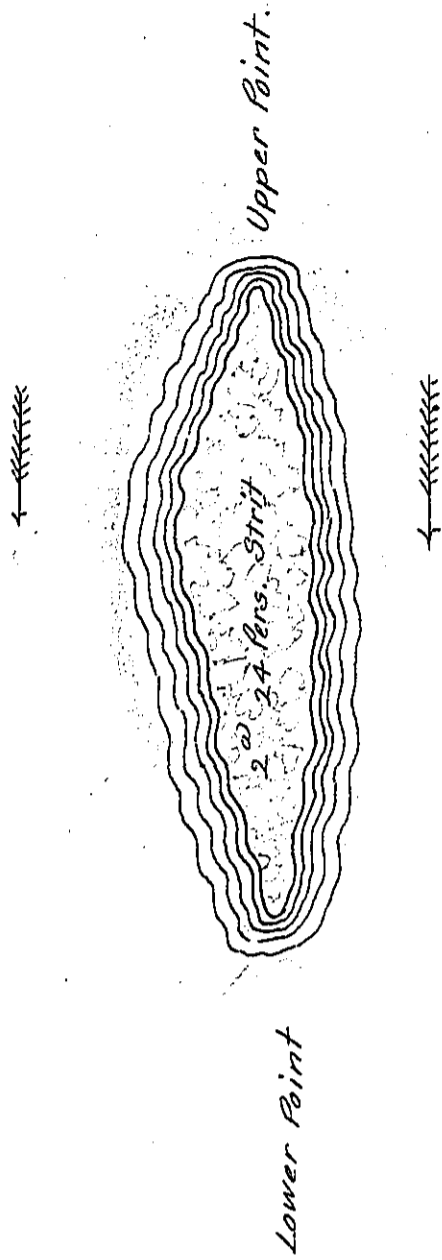


Western - York Shore

Surveyed April 18th 1815 for Peter Myers the above described Island situate in the River Susquehanna called "Laputa" opposite to land of John Brunk on the Western Shore, about forty Rods from the same Shore and one quarter of a mile below the point of the Hill Island in Derry-township Dauphin County containing Two Acres twenty four perches by Warrant of the 18th May 1810.
