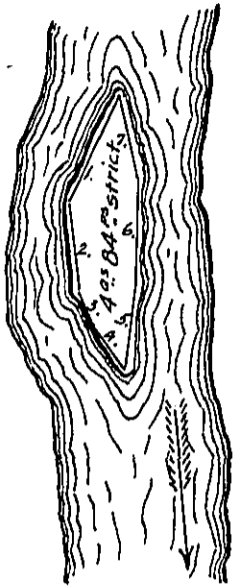


Courses and distances round Island. Beginning at a post at the upper end thence down right side.
