



A Draft of a Tract of Land situate in Washington Township in the County of Franklin Containing ninety five Acres 96 perches and the Allowance of Six & Cent &c Survey'd 5<sup>th</sup> November 1802 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Michael Miller bearing date 27<sup>th</sup> March 1801. The above described Tract was included in a General Survey made for John Holker Esq. on a number of Warrants in the year 1792. The Improvements said by the neighbors to have been on it at the time of Making Mr Holkers Survey, were a small Cabbin, 3 or 4 Acres of Cleared land & a few fruit Trees planted - the Cabbin is now gone. A small House & Stable have since been built.
