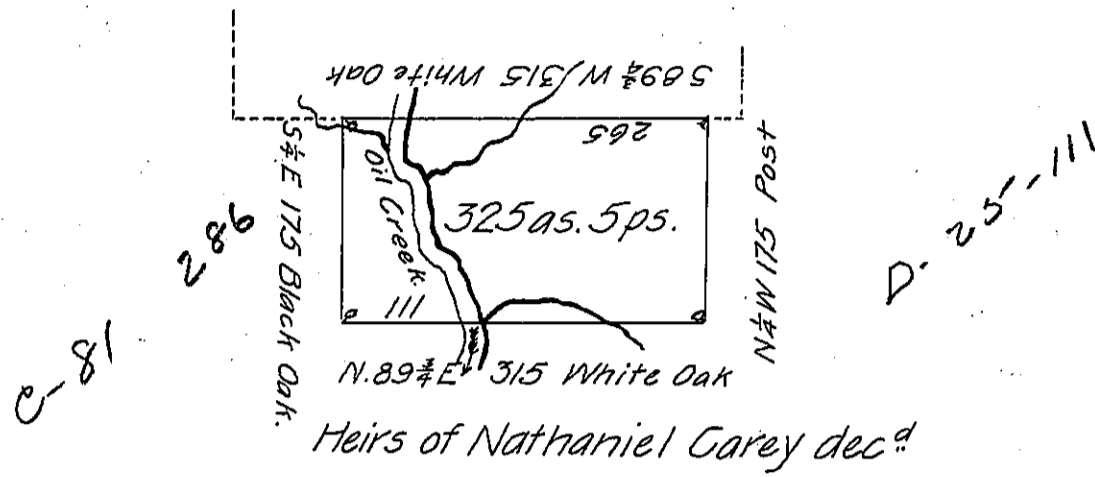


Samuel Hays

Draft of a tract of land situate partly in Sugar-creek & Alleghany townships, Venango County west of the Alleghany River, on Oil-Creek, Containing three hundred and twenty-five acres & five perches & allowance. Adjoining lands of Heirs of Nathaniel Carey dec<sup>d</sup> on the South and Samuel Hays on the North.

Surveyed 15<sup>th</sup> January 1819 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Hamilton M<sup>c</sup>Clintick dated 31<sup>st</sup> January 1817.

The above is a copy of the original entry made by a former Deputy Surveyor on the Books in my office, Witness my hand this 30<sup>th</sup> July A.D. 1857
