



The Draft of a tract of land situate in Haines Township Centre County Containing fifty five Acres eight Seven perches and allowance of Six per Cent &c Surveyed the 15th day of December 1810 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Mary Moatz Widow of John Moatz dec'd in trust for the Heirs of Said John Moatz dated the 31st day of October 1810. The survey mad on this warrant has been returned into the Surveyor General's office in January 1810, the whole of that Survey was then claimed by Jacob Hosterman, Since which time a decision has taken place at Court in favor of Mary Moatz for the part above discribed. And at the request of the said Mary Moatz, a Second Return is forwarded clear of interference. The lines examined, and the parties on the ground the 3rd day of May AD. 1820.
