



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Upper Milford Township in the County of Northampton in the State of Pennsylvania Containing Forty Eight Acres and 35 Perches of Land and the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads. Being the greatest Part of a Tract of about 50 1/2 ct allowance. That was formerly Surveyed to Michael Meyer Senior deceased, by Virtue of a Warrant granted to him by the Late Proprietaries Dated on the 25th January Anno 1744. the same was by him devised to his son Michael Meyer who sold about 21 acres thereof to his Brother Conrad Meyer and the Remainder to Daniel Kreter who again sold above 26 1/2 thereof to Gabriel Poppenmeyer and kept 2 1/2 86 pete. thereof for himself. Then he the said Gabriel Poppenmeyer sold the said ^{tract} of above 26 acres etc also to the said Conrad Meyer who is now in Possession of the above whole Tract. who intends to get out a Patent for the same. formerly Surveyed and now drawn for the Said Conrad Meyer By order of the Surveyor General on the 27th July Anno 1789.
