Note. the above Tract of Land had been Surveyed the 10th of May 1790 on a Warrant to John Mears dated November 11th 1786 on land which had been improved on by Dennis Leary but was represented to me as Vacant & without any direct Right and by the direction of John Mears who I conceived to be the Representative of Dennis Leary, and who afterwards when he had actually undertaken the administration of Learys Estate directed the Surveying of Bernard Kepple where it was laid on July 17th 1790 and from whence it is now contended it ought to be removed and placed agreeably to the above Draught. ~ Certify'd this 16th May 1795.
