



The foregoing is a part of a Survey made to Samuel Perry Esq^r in Rt. of John Perry 7th Nov^r. 1770 on order of Survey N^o. 3169 of 24. April 1769 Situate in Dunbar township Fayette (then Cumberland) County. this part now belongs to Alex^r. M-Clelland who wishes to procure a patent. I have therefore at his request made a Survey of this part and now returns it for that purpose. I believe M^r. M-Clelland has the necessary vouchers for his claim. there is 70 or 80 acres cleared, and an old house on the tract. 30 Ap^r. 1829.
