



A Draft of a Tract of Land situate in Newton Township in the County of Cumberland Containing One hundred Acres and the Allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent for Roads &c^a being Part of 147 Acres Survey'd the 8th of August 1786 & returned in Dispute between Joseph Mc Donald and Alexander Mc Clintuck, who have since by mutual Agreement referred the same to Men appointed for that Purpose, by whose Decision the above one hundred Acres and Allowance is now, August 4th 1789, laid off for Joseph Mc Donald in pursuance of his Warrant bearing Date the 26th Day of April 1786.
