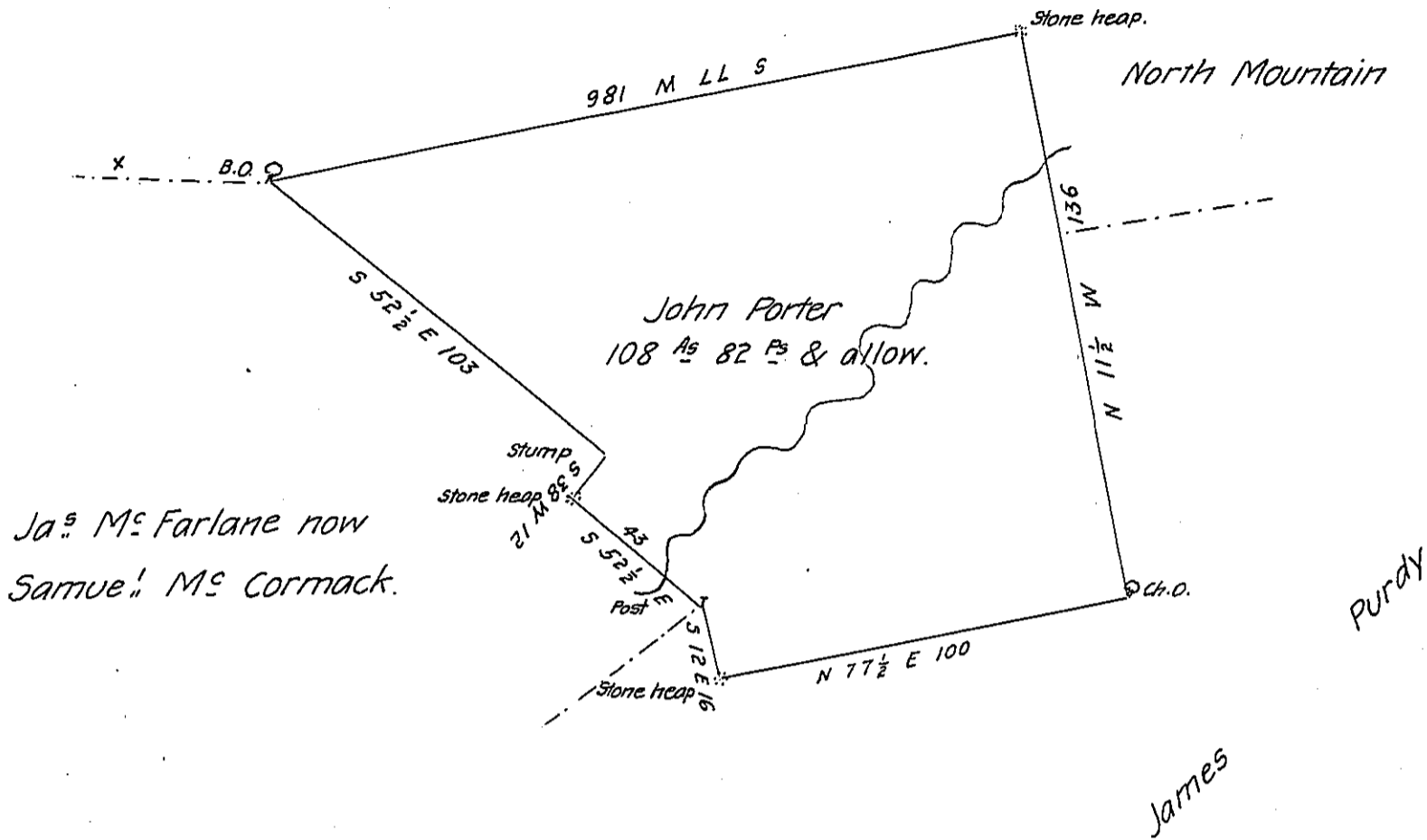


Stephon Porter formerly said to be
