



Situate on the North side of the West branch of Susquehanna River and including the upper end of a small Ridg. known by the name of the Bald Hill, in North^d County containing 226 acres 42 perches and the usual allowance for Roads & c.

Surveyed July 10th 1793 for Robert Morris and Walter Stewart Esq^{rs} in pursuance of a Warrant No 36.50 bearing date 10th day of January 1793.
