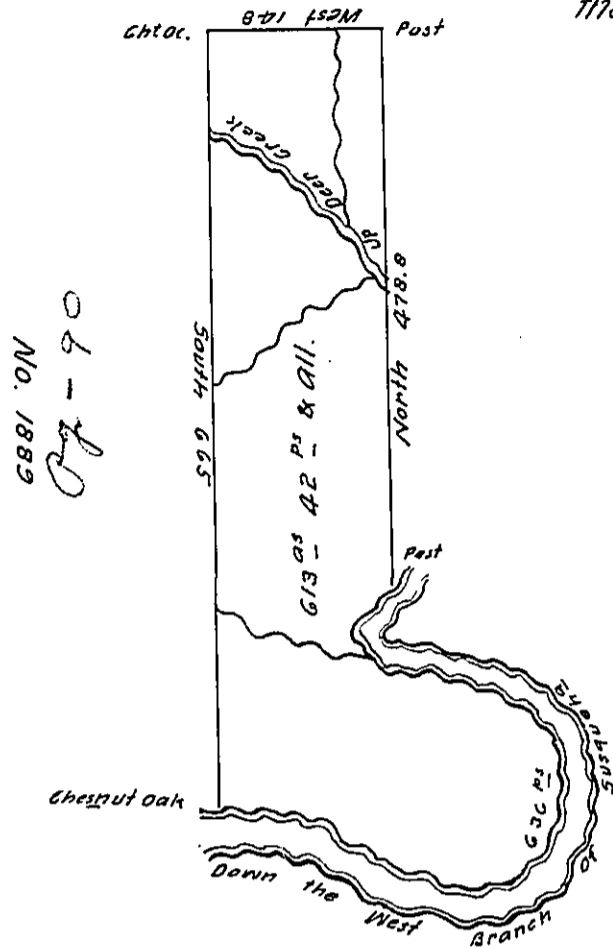


ON 1793
