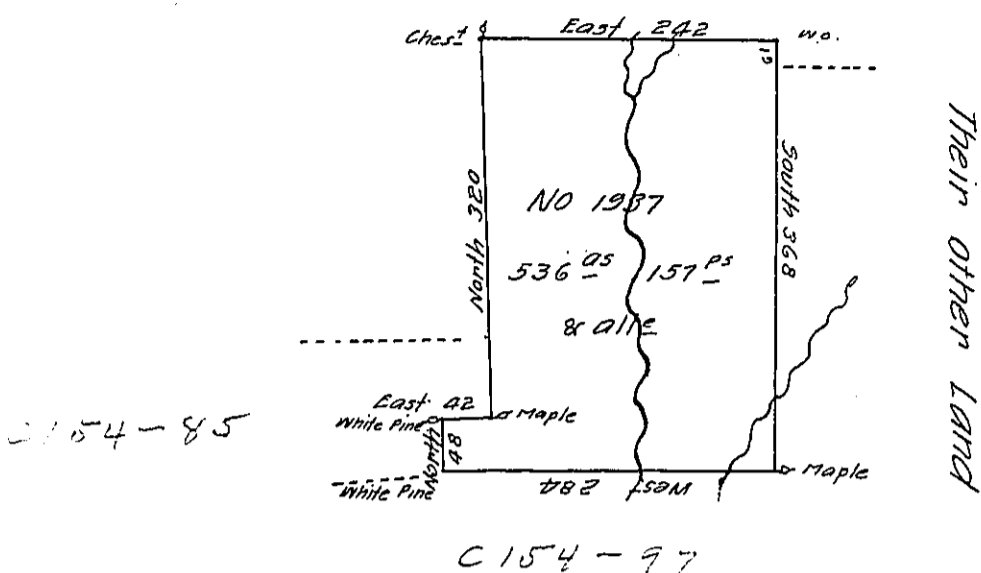


Vacant Laurel Hills

Ct & c.
