



Situate on the waters of Chest Creek, about eight miles south of the mouth of said creek and four Miles East of the West branch of the Susquehanna in Huntingdon County, containing 405<sup>ac</sup> 106 perches & the usual allowance for Roads. Survey'd the 10<sup>th</sup> day of August 1793, in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of <sup>June</sup> ~~May~~ 1793.
