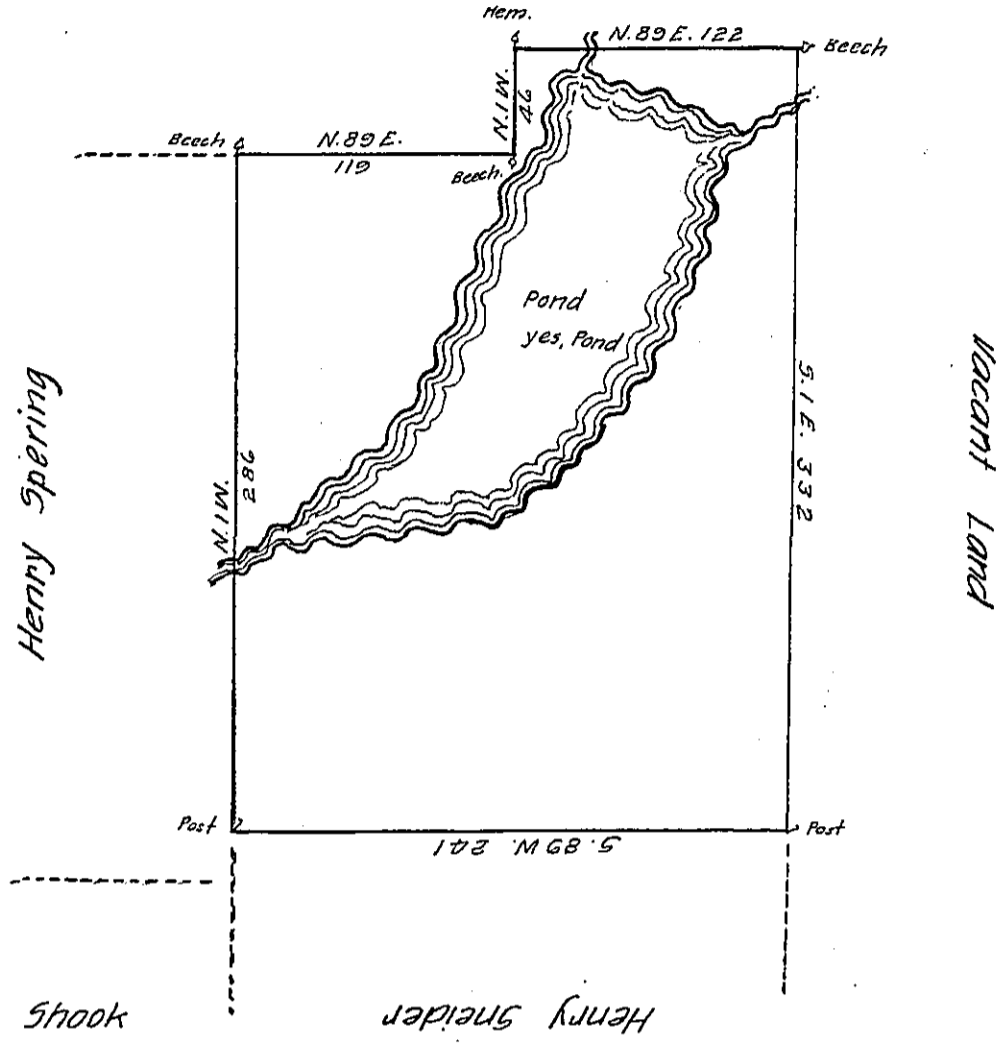


Vacant Land



By virtue of a Warrant dated the 11<sup>th</sup> October 1792 surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> November 1792, to Christopher Mixell the above described tract of Land situate on a branch of the East Branch of Wallingpau-pach Creek in the County of Northampton. Containing four hundred and thirty nine acres, seventy eight perches and the allowance of six p. Cent & ca.
