



By virtue of the Commissioners Warrant dated the thirtieth day of December 1730, there was surveyed to John Naglee Two hundred acres of Land in right of John Millington. Situate in the County of Philadelphia. Beginning at a post being a corner of Paul Hendricks Land, thence by the same North East one hundred and eighty perches to a white oak, thence by Land of John Lukins South East one hundred eighty eight perches to a post, thence South West one hundred and eighty perches to a post, thence North West one hundred and eighty perches to the place of Beginning. Containing Two Hundred Acres, with allowance of six p. Cent.
