Surveyed on the tenth day of October 1734, to William Pitts a tract of land

Situate in the township of Salford in the County of Philad^a. Begining at a Corner Post of Jacob Rieffs land thence by the land of John Ryher South east eighty four perches to a White Oak another Corner of S^d Ryher's land thence North east by land of Lawrence Hendrick ninety nine perches and the same Course by land of Gotchelick Gotchelick one hundred and twenty nine perches and by Vacant land ye same Course eleven perches to a Post in the line of Casper Wisters land thence by the same North West eighty four perches to a Post thence by Vacant land South West thirty eight perches to a Corner Post of Jacob Hoofmans land thence by that & land of Jacob Rieffs the same Course two hundred & one perches to the place of Begining. Containing one hundred and eighteen acres with usual allowance.
