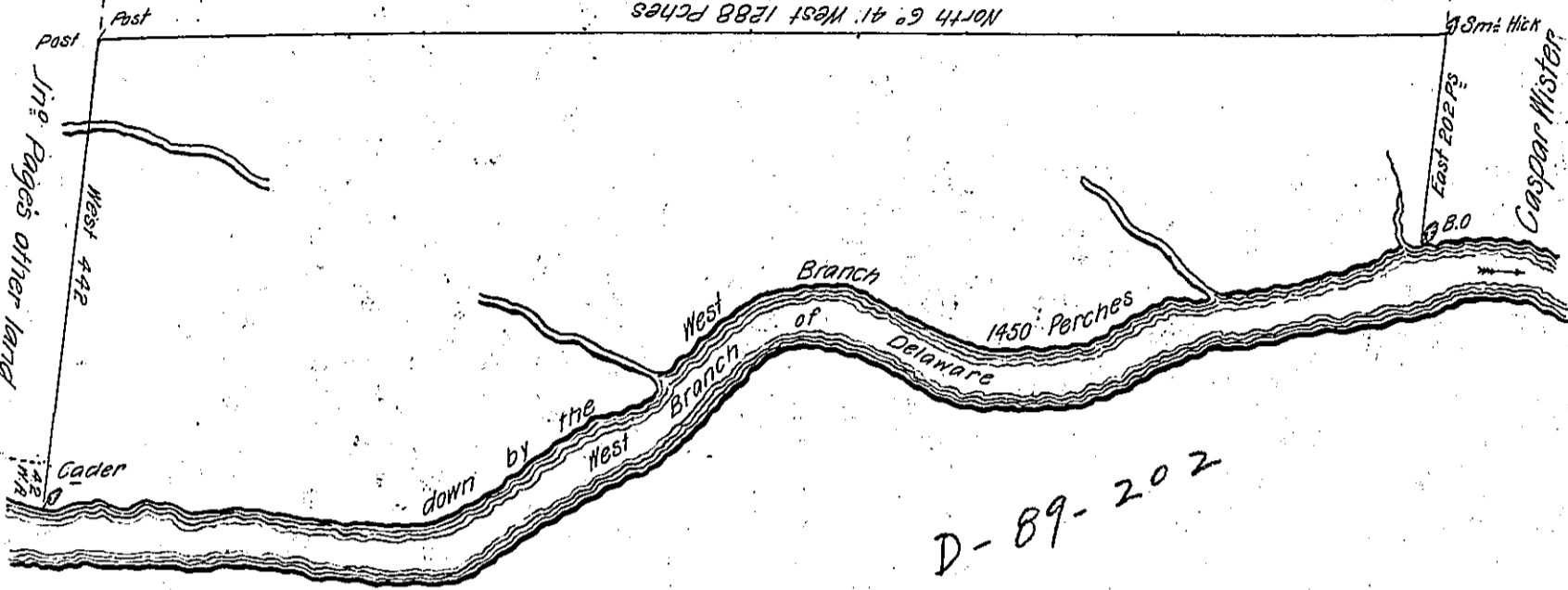


Vacant Land

North 6° 41' West 1288 Pches



Carrollton

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Nineteenth day of October 1731. Surveyed to John Page of Austin Fryers London the above described tract of land. Situate on ye East side of the West Branch of Delaware in the County of Bucks. Beginning at a Black Oak, Standing on the east Bank of said West Branch thence by land of Caspar Wister, east 202 perches to a Small Hickery thence by Vacant Land N 6° 41' West 1288 perches to a Post in a line of said Page's other Land thence by the same West 400 Pches and by land of William Allen 42 perches to a Cader standing on ye Bank of said West Branch, thence down the Severall Courses thereof to the place of Beginning. Containing 2723 acres.

Surveyed October 10th 1736.
