I Suppose an addition was made to ye first Survey that ye sd Persons hold by John Taylor on Robert Boles Part agreeable to ye Pricked lines If so, then Robt hath more of ye sd first Survey by about 8 acres then John Poston who hath ^{in my opinion} an opportunity to make as valuable an addition as Boyle hath had & more so on account of Timber
