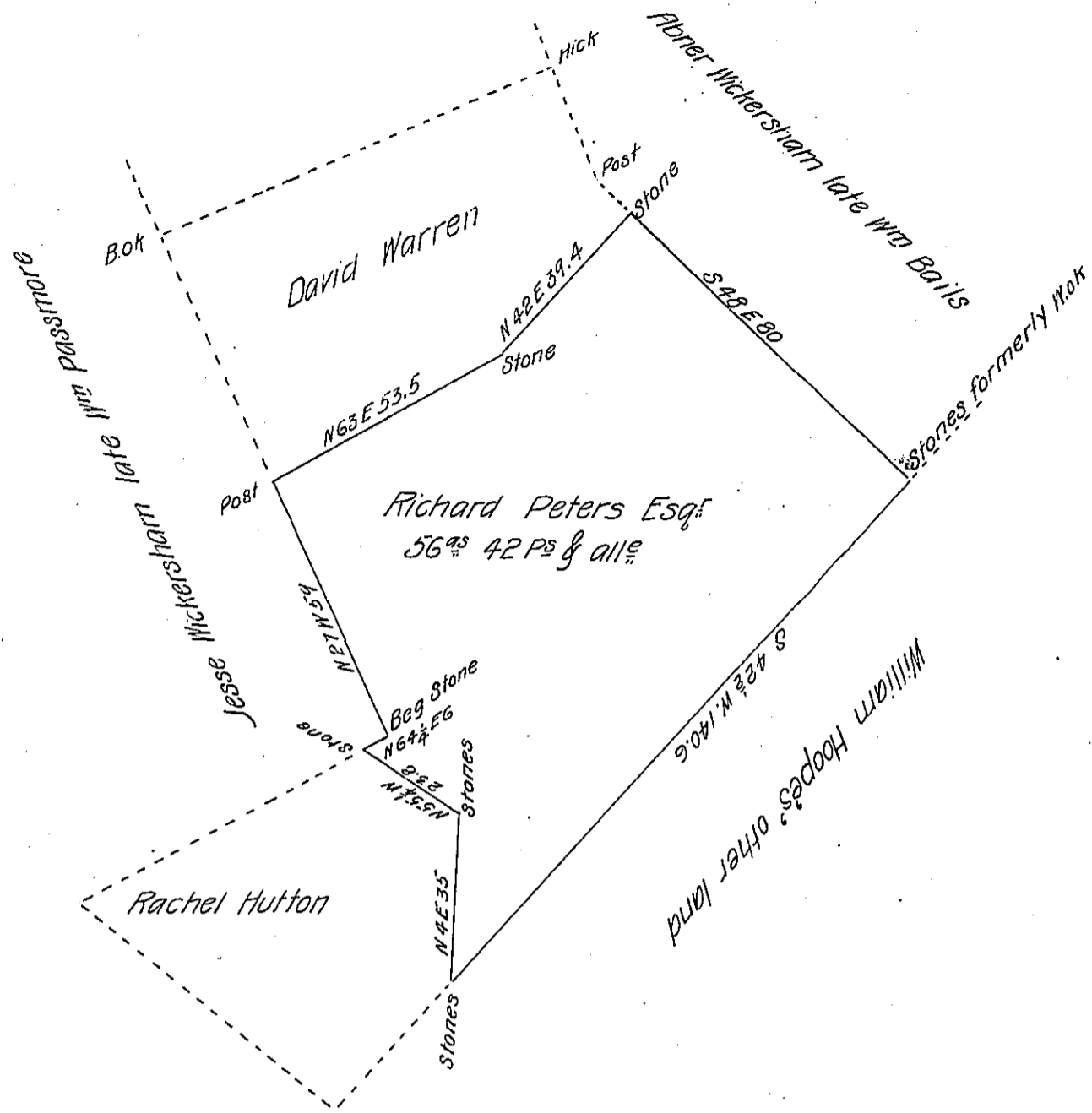


FORM No. 1.



Situate in Newbury township in the County of York containing as above set forth, fifty six acres forty two perches and the usual allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads &c., being part of a larger tract of 95 1/2 acs and allowance of land originally surveyed by George Stevenson late D. S. on the 20th day of March 1754 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Richard Peters Esq. for bearing date the 30th day of October 1753. The above part Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 22nd day of December 1821, and now at the request of William Hoopes the present owner of the said part is returned for Confirmation, 9th January 1822.
