Being a part of a larger tract of 32 1/4 120 1/2 Surveyed on the 24th of the 6th mo 1764 by William Matthews late D.S. in pursuance of a Warrant bearing date the 19th day of may 1774. Granted to John Strickhouser for 50%. Afterwards divided off from the said larger tract. And now after having been Carefully examined Corrected & Calculated, it is at the Request of the present owner, Henry Strickhouser Returned for Confirmation the 23rd day of August Anno Domini 1809.
