



A Draft of a Tract of Land situate in Antrim Township in the County of Cumberland Containing two hundred & four Acres and thirty three Perches and an Allowance of Six P Cent for Roads being Part of a Tract of 327 1/4 Acres and Allowance formerly survey'd in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Lawrence O. Gallagher Dated May 24th 1753 and (as is alleged) by him conveyed to a certain Moses Little, who conveyed the same to Michael McAnulty, who has since laid off and conveyed away the other Part of said Tract and retains the Part above described. Calculated and laid down (exclusive of the Part last conveyed as aforesaid) this 27th Day of November 1783.
